#### **Essential skills and experience:**

1. Proven experience in theatre with the ability to plan and conduct theatre workshops.
2. Demonstrated commitment to working with young people or experience in the development of

- artistic projects for young people.
3. Knowledge of performance and production processes and experience working as a member of a creative team.
  4. A high standard of verbal and written communication and interpersonal skills including the ability to communicate effectively with young people, parents, education professionals and fellow artists.
  5. Strong organisational skills and the ability to work with minimal supervision.
  6. A current Working With Vulnerable People clearance.

**Desirable skills and knowledge:**

7. Performing Arts or Drama Teaching qualifications.
8. A current First Aid certificate

- Cover Letter (indicating subject areas and age ranges you would like to teach).
- CV (indicating any professional or teaching experience).
- Contact details of two work related referees
